



INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR TUITION ASSISTANCE

1. You may complete the Yeshivat Kadimah application online at <https://www.solutionsbysss.com>. If you have already completed an application for another school, please add Kadimah's SSS Subscriber code, **195242**, to your existing on-line application with SSS, and complete the upload of the required supporting tax documents.
2. Once on the website, select 'Website for Parents and Families.' You will then be asked to 'Apply for Financial Aid.' The fee to file online is \$49, Kadimah's SSS Subscriber code is 195242. If you have any questions, call the "School and Student Services (SSS) helpline at (800) 344-8328, or our Treasurer, Zev Fredman, at (314) 409-6077.
 - a. For additional information before completing the application, go to the 'PFS Online Workbook,' located on the PFS Status Dashboard tab, under the heading 'Prepare to Apply.' This guide will address many issues related to the SSS program and help explain the basics of applying for financial aid.
 - b. Read carefully the instructions of the Parents' Financial Statement (PFS). Incomplete statements or insufficient information could result in School and Student Services requesting further information, thereby delaying the processing of your application.
3. **The deadline for filing your scholarship assistance form is March 15, 2018. Since scholarship funds are limited and the initial processing of the applications will occur shortly after the deadline, we encourage you to complete the process as soon as possible. Applications received after the deadline are not guaranteed consideration.**
4. Complete all items. Questions marked with an asterisk (*) are critical. Your PFS cannot be accepted without this information. If you are unable to provide actual figures, give your best estimate.

Please note the scholarship recommendation made by SSS is *only a recommendation*. The ultimate responsibility for the allocation of scholarship remains with the scholarship committee.

When the Scholarship Committee makes its findings known to you, it will also provide a contact for registering an appeal.
